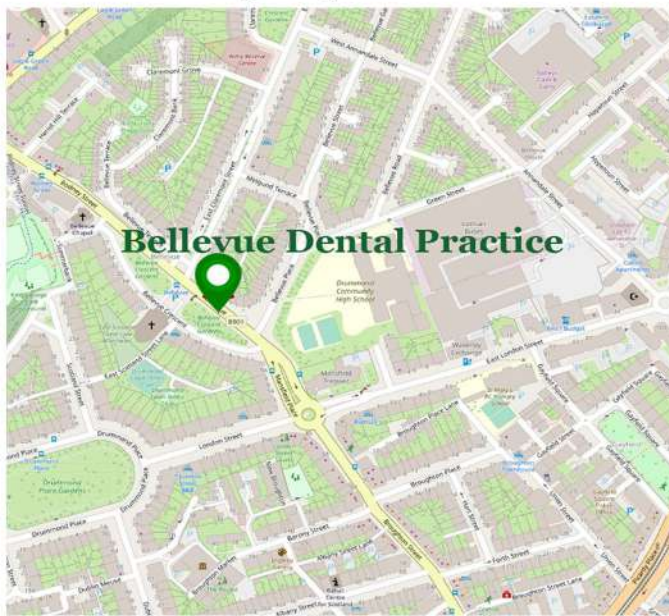

What is Dental Sedation?

Dental Sedation, or "Twilight Sedation" is a very safe and effective way of making you very relaxed in the chair.

Unlike a general anaesthetic, you are not completely asleep, BUT, you may well feel afterwards that you have been. You may occasionally nod off but you should be able to open your mouth when we ask.

Time goes very quickly, a few hours can feel like about twenty minutes. You get a lot of amnesia during and after, meaning you have little memory of the dental treatment.

Once you are sedated, you will then be numbed up so it's unlikely you'll feel anything. If you do feel anything we will know and make sure you have more local anaesthetic.

Dental Sedation has helped thousands of people get the treatment they need without the stress of having it done.

What Do You Need to Know?

Sedation is carried out using a fine cannula inserted into a vein in your arm or hand. If you are nervous of that part, there are things we can do to help.

It takes effect after about 30 seconds, making you feel like you've had a glass of wine. We then ramp it up until your eyes are gently closing and you are feeling relaxed.

We stay in the room and monitor your vital signs throughout to make sure everything is safe. After the treatment is finished you should be able to stand without much help.

You will be feeling relaxed and happy for the remainder of the day so make sure you don't do anything responsible, like **driving, cooking, looking after children, spending money, using a mobile phone or drinking alcohol.**

Someone responsible needs to bring you, stay during treatment, get you home and look after you for the rest of the day.

Don't worry, we will give you all the fine details and written instructions you need beforehand.
